(Accra, Ghana) – The Kofi Annan International Peacekeeping Training Centre (KAIPTC) in Teshie, in collaboration with Paynet Limited an electronic payment solutions company are holding a one-day anti-fraud and internet security seminar on Thursday, 31 May at the KAIPTC.
